

NEW PRICING & OPTIONS (as of Feb. 2018)

Single Ride

\$3 / trip

Great for quick trips (Per 30 minute ride) **Explorer Pass**

\$15 / day

Perfect for tourists and exploring Chicago (Unlimited 3-hour rides in a 24-hour period) **Annual Membership**

\$99 / year

Best deal for locals and frequent riders (Unlimited 45-minute trips for a year)

MORE RIDE TIME FOR MEMBERS!

45 minutes

NEW USAGE FEE STRUCTURE

• \$3/30 min

DIVVY FOR EVERYONE (D4E)

- » Address credit card requirement
 - 3 12.7% of Chicago households are unbanked
 - 34% of Chicago households live on less than \$30,000/year (Bankon.org)
- » Daily cost breakdown of Divvy membership is approx. \$0.30/day
- » Affordable transportation should be available to all Chicagoans


DIVVY TO DATE


Network

- 571 active stations
- 5700+ bikes
- Includes suburb of Evanston

Ridership

- 28 million+ miles traveled
- 14 million+ trips
 - 10.6 million member trips
 - 3.8 million casual trips
- ~37,000 annual members
- 1,400+ D4E members





FEASIBILLITY & HEAT MAPPING


STANDARD BIKESHARE SITING CRITERIA

- Existing bikeways network
- High existing bicycle modeshare
- High population Density
- High business Density

EQUITY FOCUSED CRITERIA

- Populations of color
- Lower annual household income
- Lower educational attainment
- Low car ownership
- High transit modeshare





EASY TO INSTALL

FAST: Install under an hour

EASILY-MOVED: Solar and wireless

CHALLENGING TO SITE

Use street view and visit potential sites to rule out constraints:

- 12 foot sidewalk
- 42 feet in length (15 dock station)
- 15 feet from fire hydrants
- No manholes or other obstructions
- Decent solar exposure





CHICAGO DOCKLESS PILOT

• May 1 – November 1, 2018

Maximum 250 bikes per vendor

 Lock-to requirement phase-in by July 1
